Dear Philadelphia Water Department Customer, Property Owner, and/or Current Occupant,

You are receiving this letter as a notification that a Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) construction job is beginning in your neighborhood. **Water mains will be replaced** to increase service reliability and reduce the chance of breakages. This project is also part of the City of Philadelphia's *Green City, Clean Waters* initiative – a 25-year plan to improve the quality of our waterways by **installing green stormwater infrastructure (GSI)** in our neighborhoods.

Our work will take place in the coming months on the blocks listed below, in your neighborhood. As a neighbor in this community, we want you to be aware of possible disruptions and traffic delays while this work is ongoing. This project will take place at these locations:
