Dear Philadelphia Water Customer,

I am writing to let you know that the Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) is planning a construction project in your neighborhood. The planned project will take place **on your street and on the sidewalks near your property.**

This project is a part of the City of Philadelphia's *Green City, Clean Waters* – a program that keeps pollution out of rivers and creeks by using green tools to absorb stormwater that would normally overflow into our waterways during heavy storms. As part of this initiative, PWD is planning to install green tools at the following locations:

- E. Godfrey St., Newtown Ave. to Colgate St.
- Weymouth St., E. Sanger St. to Cheltenham Ave.
- Reach St., E. Sanger St. to Cheltenham Ave.
- E. Sanger Street, Reach St. to Hasbrook Ave.
- Hasbrook Ave., E. Sanger St. to Sentner St.
- Hasbrook Ave., Cheltenham Ave. to Van Kirk St.
- Cheltenham Ave., Hasbrook Ave. to Colgate St.
- Sentner St., Hasbrook Ave. to Colgate St.
- Alcott St., Hasbrook Ave. to Rising Sun Ave.
- Van Kirk St., Hasbrook Ave. to Rising Sun Ave.
- Howell St., Hasbrook Ave. to Rising Sun Ave.
- Colgate St., E Godfrey Ave. to Van Kirk St.
- Allengrove St., E Godfrey Ave. to Bingham St.
- Bingham St., Dead end to Allengrove St.

Green tools installed in this location will include subsurface storage, stormwater bumpouts, tree trenches, and new piping. Construction is expected to begin in approximately 2-6 months. However, **please note that this is an estimate and the construction start date can be earlier or later than the anticipated timeline.**
