Dear Philadelphia Water Customer,

I am writing to let you know that the Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) is planning two construction projects in your neighborhood. The planned projects will take place along **24**th **Street and along Snyder and McKean Streets near your property.**

This project is a part of the City of Philadelphia's *Green City, Clean Waters* initiative — a program that keeps pollution out of rivers and creeks by using green tools to absorb stormwater that would normally overflow into our waterways during heavy storms. As part of the **24th Street Greening (#50210)** and **Snyder Ave Greening (#50207) projects,** PWD is planning to install the following green tools at the following locations:

- Stormwater Infiltration Trenches on McKean St from S 22nd St to S Bonsall St
- Stormwater Tree Trench on McKean St from S Bonasll St to S 24th St
- Stormwater Bumpout on McKean St from S 23rd St to S Hemberger St
- Stormwater Tree Trenches on Snyder Ave from S Woodstock to 23rd St
- Stormwater Raingardens on medians along 24th St from Point Breeze Ave to Passyunk Ave

Construction is expected to begin in approximately **2-6 months**. However, **please note that this is an estimate and the construction start date can be earlier or later than the anticipated timeline**.
