Dear Philadelphia Water Customer,

I am writing to let you know that the Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) is planning a construction project in your neighborhood. The planned project will take place **on your street and on the sidewalks near your property.**

This project is a part of the City of Philadelphia's *Green City, Clean Waters* – a program that keeps pollution out of rivers and creeks by using green tools to absorb stormwater that would normally overflow into our waterways during heavy storms. As part of this initiative, PWD is planning to install green tools at the following locations:

- Bingham St., Van Kirk St. to Comly St.
- Elsinore St., Van Kirk St. to Comly St.
- Palmetto St., Van Kirk St. to Comly St.
- Malta St., Van Kirk St. to Comly St.
- Comly St., Lawndale St. to Bennington St.
- Comly St., Bingham St. to Lawndale St.
- Comly St., Elsinore St. to Bingham St.
- Comly St., Palmetto St. to Elsinore St.
- Comly St., Malta St. to Palmetto St.
- Comly St., Colgate St. to Malta St.
- Colgate St., Comly St. to Benner St.
- Lawndale St., Comly St. to Benner St.
- Van Kirk St., Rising Sun Ave. to Colgate St.
- Van Kirk St., Colgate St. to Malta St.

Green tools installed in this location will include subsurface storage, stormwater bumpouts, tree trenches, and new piping. Construction is expected to begin in approximately 1-3 months. However, please note that this is an estimate and the construction start date can be earlier or later than the anticipated timeline.
