Dear Philadelphia Water Customer,

I am writing to let you know that the Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) is planning a construction project in your neighborhood. The planned project will take place on Awbury Park property and the sidewalk adjacent to Awbury Recreation Center.

This project is a part of the City of Philadelphia's *Green City, Clean Waters* initiative – a 25-year program that keeps pollution out of rivers and creeks by using green tools to absorb stormwater that would normally overflow into our waterways during heavy storms. As part of the **Awbury Rec Center (#50241) project,** PWD is planning to install the following green tools at the Recreation Center location:

- Rain gardens
- Swales
- Infiltration storage trenches

Construction is expected to begin in approximately **2-6 months**. However, please note that **this is an estimate** and the construction start date can be earlier or later than the anticipated timeline.
