Dear Philadelphia Water Customer:

You are receiving this letter as a notification that a Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) construction job is beginning in your neighborhood. PWD has identified the water mains below as those that need to be replaced, to increase service reliability and reduce the chance of breakages.

This project is also part of the City of Philadelphia’s *Green City, Clean Waters* initiative – a 25-year plan to improve the quality of our waterways by installing green stormwater infrastructure (GSI) in our neighborhoods. Our work will take place in the coming months on the blocks listed below, in your neighborhood. **As a neighbor in this community, you will not be directly impacted by the work**; we do want you to be aware of possible traffic disruptions and delays while this work is ongoing. - Should you experience any problems as a result of the work, please talk with the inspector on the job site who will be wearing clothing identifying them as a PWD employee; their contact information is also on the Project Page
- If a water service line needs to be shut-off, the inspector will notify your block one day in advance

If you are unable to contact the inspector at the job site, or have any other questions, please contact the engineer at the number listed below between 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday. Should a water emergency occur, please call the Water Department at 215-685-6300.
