Dear Philadelphia Water Customer:

You are receiving this letter as a notification that a Water Department construction job is soon to begin in your neighborhood. The blocks listed below are the blocks on which work will soon take place; however, as a neighbor in the same community, we want you to be aware of possible traffic disruptions and delays while this work is ongoing.

PWD has identified the water mains and sewer pipes below as those that need to be replaced, to increase service reliability and reduce the chance of breakages. This project will also include sewer lining construction and the installation of green stormwater infrastructure (GSI) ‘tools’. For more information, visit: water.phila.gov/green-city/. Work will take place at the following locations:

- Should you experience any problems as a result of the work, talk with the inspector on the job site who will be wearing clothing identifying them as a PWD employee; their contact information is on the Project Page site above
- If a water service line needs to be shut-off, the inspector will notify your block one day in advance

If you are unable to contact the inspector at the job site, or have any other questions, please contact the engineer at the number listed below between 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday. 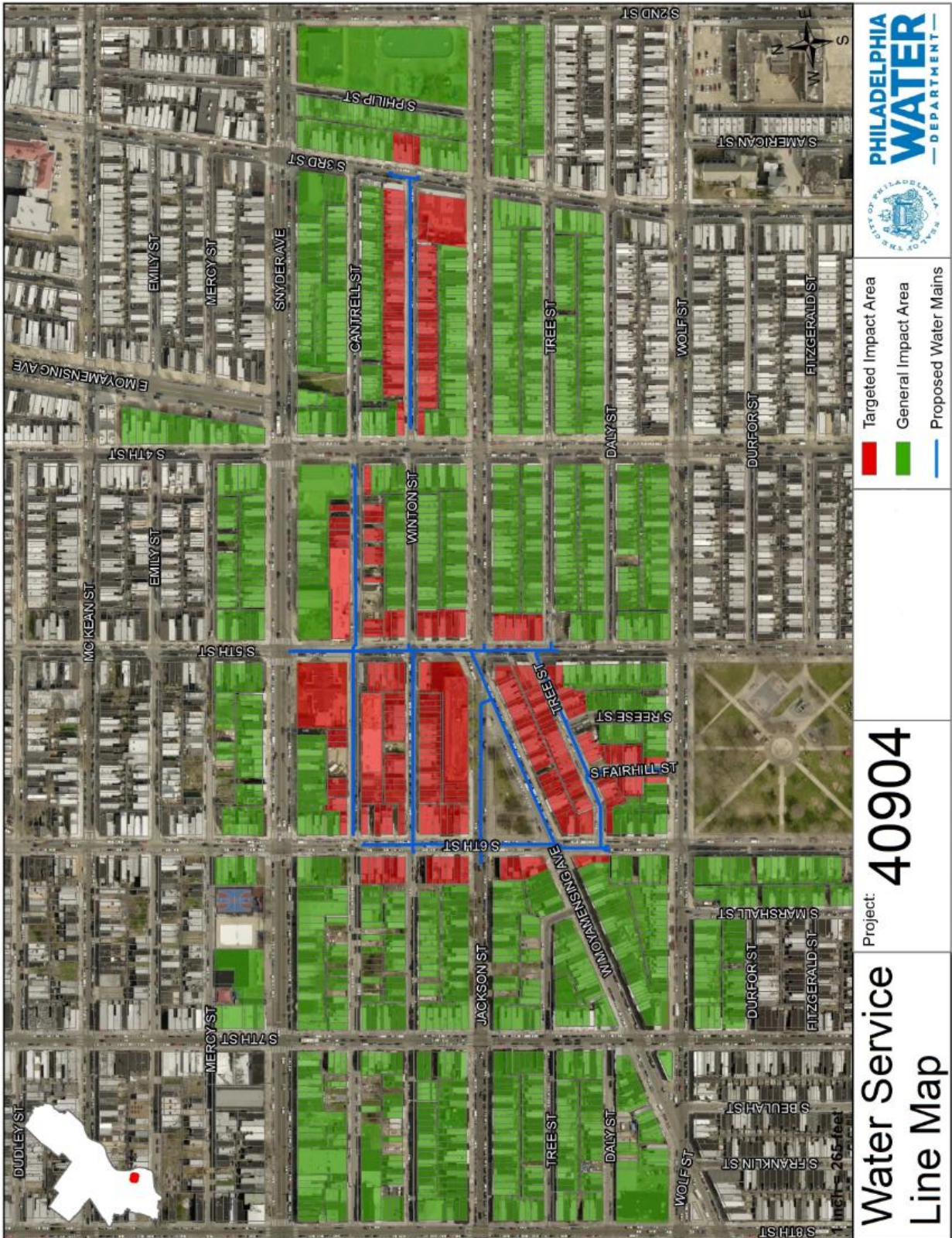
