Dear Philadelphia Water Customer:

You are receiving this letter as a notification that a Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) construction job is beginning in your neighborhood. PWD has identified the water and sewer mains below as those that need to be replaced, to increase service reliability and reduce the chance of breakages. This project will also install green stormwater infrastructure (GSI).

Our work will take place in the coming months on the blocks listed below, in your neighborhood. As a neighbor in this community, you will not be directly impacted by the work; we do want you to be aware of possible disruptions and traffic delays while this work is ongoing. This project will take place at these locations:

- PWD inspector will be wearing 'PWD Employee' clothing; contact information is also found on Project Page site
- If a water service line needs to be shut-off, the inspector will notify your block one day in advance
