Construction is starting soon for a Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) infrastructure project in your neighborhood. This project is called **SAP5 Priority Reconstruction Work (PWD Project #41209)**. The contractor assigned to this job is **Carusone Construction**.

**Construction is Estimated to Start in February 2026**

Construction dates may change. We will alert you before any planned service interruptions. Construction is currently expected to take place from **January 2026 – Fall 2026**.

**Construction Impacts**


- Typical construction hours are from 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM but can vary seasonally.
- Street parking and road access during hours of construction may be restricted. Temporary “No Parking” signs will be installed as needed for safety and construction.
- Pedestrian access, trash collection, and deliveries will be maintained.
- Residents should expect disruptions of water service for **house connections to new pipes** and when **water main connections are completed**. Residents will be notified for expected shutoffs.

**Reason for Project**

- **New water mains** to increase service reliability and reduce emergency breaks
  - **Lead service line replacement** for eligible properties with confirmed lead service lines discovered during water main installation. (Customers will be contacted and are required to sign a separate permission form.)
- **New sewers or sewer lining work** to increase system capacity and reduce flooding
