



Project #50169 Bid Letter | Construction in 3-9 Months | December 2024

Dear PWD Customer, Property Owner, and/or Current Occupant,

This is the first in a series of construction letters to let you know that the Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) is **planning a construction project** in your neighborhood.

This project is called **Grays Ferry Neighborhood GSI Stormsewer (PWD GSI Project #50169)** and will increase the service reliability and climate resilience of your neighborhood. It will take place in the public right of way (streets & sidewalks) and connect a new stormwater network to an existing green stormwater infrastructure (GSI) system at Lanier Playground (GSI Project #50102, completed 2016). **The construction of #50169 is estimated to begin in 3-9 months.**

In certain areas, new water and/or sewer infrastructure will be installed. In summary, these improvements will look like the following:

- **New GSI Stormsewer** to collect & manage stormwater to protect local waterways
- **New Water Mains** to increase service reliability & reduce emergency breaks
- **New Sewer Mains** to increase service reliability & reduce clogs and back-ups

Since this project contains different types of infrastructure upgrades, you will see it phased into different types of work, **each within its own unique timeline**. At times, you may experience short, temporary service interruptions. PWD will alert you one business day before planned, longer-period service interruptions. Public GSI projects like this one are built through our 25-year combined sewer overflow (CSO) reduction plan called **Green City, Clean Waters**; learn more about it here: water.phila.gov/green-city/

PWD takes **Lead Service Lines (LSL) replacements** very seriously. If a water main that is actively being replaced by PWD has a lead line attached to it, we will consult the property owner and replace the LSL for free during construction. For more info, please visit: water.phila.gov/lead

The contractor assigned to this job is JPC Group, Inc. and **the construction timeline (3-9 months) is subject to change**. Another letter will be sent closer to the time of construction.
