Dear Philadelphia Water Customer,

I am writing to let you know that the Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) is planning two construction projects in your neighborhood. The planned projects and their project pages are:

- **229 E Logan Street Lot (#50201):** water.phila.gov/50201
- **Bringhurst Playground (#50202):** water.phila.gov/50202

These projects are a part of the City of Philadelphia's *Green City, Clean Waters* initiative – a 25-year plan that keeps pollution out of rivers and creeks by using green tools to absorb stormwater that could overflow into our waterways. For more information, visit: water.phila.gov/green-city/.

As part of these projects, PWD is planning to install the following green tools at the locations below:

- A rain garden and an infiltration storage trench at the vacant lot at 229 E Logan St.
- A rain garden and tree trench at Bringhurst Park
- Subsurface storage trenches at the following locations:
 - a. Along Clapier St. from Germantown Ave. to Wakefield St.
 - b. Along Sheldon St. from Elwood St. to Stenton Ave.
 - c. Along Stenton Ave. from Shedaker St. to Rubicam St.

Construction will begin in various stages throughout the next year. **It is estimated that work will start in approximately 2-6 months**, but please note that the start date can be earlier or later than the anticipated timeline.

Each project will have its own inspector and construction team, as well as a specific project timeline. PWD will provide that information in a follow up letter closer to the time of construction.
