Dear Philadelphia Water Customer,

I am writing to let you know that the Philadelphia Water Department (PWD) is planning a construction project in your neighborhood. The planned project will take place **on your street and on the sidewalks near your property.**

This project is a part of the City of Philadelphia's *Green City, Clean Waters* initiative — a program that keeps pollution out of rivers and creeks by using green tools to absorb stormwater that would normally overflow into our waterways during heavy storms. As part of this initiative, PWD is planning to install green tools at the following locations:

- 6 Subsurface Stormwater trenches: along Penrose Ave between Lanier Ave. and 22nd St.
- Rain garden and swale: on median on Penrose Ave between 26th St and Palmero Dr.
- Rain garden: in traffic triangle at Penrose Ave and Penrose Ferry

Street Affected: Penrose Ave. from S. 22nd St. to S. 26th St

Construction is expected to begin in approximately **2-6 months**. However, **please note that this is an estimate and the construction start date can be earlier or later than the anticipated timeline**.
