POSITION OVERVIEW	Philadelphia are charged for stormwater management services based on the property's area and characteristics. Residential properties receive a uniform monthly charge. Non-residential and Condominium properties are charged based on property-specific measurements of property and the amount of impervious area. The Stormwater Billing team is responsible for maintenance and quality assurance of key GIS datasets associated with parcel-based stormwater billing, administering the Stormwater Appeals Program, Stormwater Customer Assistance Program (CAP), and Stormwater Garden Discounts Program.		
DUTIES AND RESPONSIBLITIES	The selected candidate will join the Stormwater Billing team and will work closely with the Incentives team to maintain the parcel-based billing system. The candidate will primarily be editing GIS data versioned SDE in a SQL Server environment. Experience with SQL Server, python, or other programming languages is preferred. The position involves working with other PWD units, other City departments, and external customers to identify and resolve data and billing issues. Some example tasks include: Review and update parcel boundaries and impervious area as needed Process stormwater appeals, CAP applications, and community gardens applications Confirm the accuracy of geocoding results Coordinate with the Water Revenue Bureau to correct billing errors Analyze billing data and process data requests
