Semi-Annual Compliance Reports are Due NO LATER THAN January 31, 2022.

Submitting your Semi-Annual Compliance Report more than 30-days late is considered Significant Non-Compliance.

Compliance Assistance

Accidental Spill Prevention / Slug Control Plan

What is spill/ or slug discharge?

Spill or Slug Discharge: Any discharge of a non-routine, episodic nature, including, but not limited to, an accidental spill or non-customary batch discharge, or any discharge at a flow rate or concentration which could cause a violation of the prohibited discharge standards found in PWD Regulations Section 501.3, Section 501.4 and Section 501.5.

No person shall store or handle any material, including hazardous substances defined by CERCLA, in any area draining to the City Wastewater System. Such storage or handling shall be subject to review by the City, and shall require a spill control plan with reasonable safeguards to prevent discharge or leakage of such materials into the sewers.

Each Significant Industrial User shall provide protection from accidental discharge of prohibited materials or other substances which may interfere with the POTW by developing an Accidental Spill Prevention/ Slug Control Plan (ASPP/SCP).

What is the Accidental Spill Prevention Plan/ Slug Control Plan?

The Accidental Spill Prevention Plan/ Slug Control Plan (ASPP/SCP) is a detailed plan showing facilities and operating procedures to provide protection from any accidental discharge of prohibited materials or other substances which may interfere with the POTW. It shall be submitted to the City for review and City's written approval. ASPP/SCP shall be provided and maintained at the owner or user's own cost and expense.

Industrial User shall submit the Spill Prevention Plan/ Slug Control Plan within (3) months of the effective date of its Permit.

Spill/ Slug incident Reporting Requirement

- \Rightarrow Notify the City of the incident immediately by telephone
- \Rightarrow Notification shall include date, time, and location of discharge
- ⇒ Submit a detailed written notice within five business days, unless a different period is prescribed by the City

Failure to submit Spill/ Slug discharge report within 30 days is considered a Significant Non-Compliance. Failure to submit Spill/Slug plan is a violation of the PWDRs.
