Dear Water Department Customer,

I'm writing to inform you of an upcoming emergency job that will soon begin along Washington Avenue from Passyunk Avenue to 9<sup>th</sup> Street. This emergency project is being done to repair the sewer underground and install a new section of water main along this section of Washington Ave.

This work is due to take place on the north side of Washington Ave with the parking lane, and one travel lane being closed while the work is taking place. Traffic will still continue eastbound and westbound, but the lanes will shift to make this accommodation.

A start date is not yet known, but it is anticipated that work will begin in the next 2-3 weeks. Once we are closer to this work getting underway, you will receive an additional notification alerting you to a start date. This project is expected to last approximately 3 months once it begins.

The Water Department understands that this work may impact some of your businesses for deliveries, and we will do our best to work with you to make any accommodations possible while this project is taking place. A Water Department inspection and engineer will be assigned to this job, and their information will be shared with you in the next letter. They will be your point of contact once the job begins.
