The Stakeholder Advisory Group (SAG) will be made up of community members with an interest in Philadelphia Water Department infrastructure projects. SAG members will serve as important advocates for the Water Revitalization Plan (WRP) and will engage with the community on plan progress as well as gathering and sharing of information related to the program.

Roles and Responsibilities

Using their voices and influence within the community, these individuals are important to the overall success of the program and a vital part of our outreach and communications strategy for the WRP across the City of Philadelphia.

At a high level, the primary roles, responsibilities, and expectations of SAG members:

Serve as advocates for the Water Revitalization Plan and communicate program progress

Participate in quarterly meetings

Review and monitor program progress

Gather input from the public

Member Term Expectations and Limits

To promote equal representation across Water Revitalization Plan projects and to encourage new leadership, members of the SAG are asked to commit to an initial term of two years, with an option to serve for one additional year. If any member is unable or unwilling to fulfill their responsibilities, they may notify the PWD SAG selection committee in writing, at which time a determination will be made on the process for backfilling that member's spot.
